What you need to know for your cat's spay/neuter:

- Absolutely <u>no</u> food after midnight the night before your appointment. Water is okay).
- You will need to have an area set up for your cat to recover for about 12 days. (No running, jumping, or stairs).
- You will go upstairs (the left door to the left of our main door. The clinic is the last door on your right).
- Drop-off time: 6:30 to 8 A.M.
- Pick-up time: 1:30 **OR** 3-5 PM the same day of your appointment.
- There is a \$40 re-booking fee if you do not show up for your appointment. For cancellations, please call 607-786-7729 twenty-four hours ahead of your appointment.
- If your cat has already received a rabies vaccine, we must see proof of a rabies **certificate**. A receipt will not work, we must see a certificate at the drop-off time of your appointment. If we do not have a certificate, we are required to administer the rabies vaccine by NYS law.
- Please bring your cat in a carrier, not a box.
